

**Topic: What happens if our experiment works ?**

The speech of our initiator Bernd Siebler on the occasion of the press conference when launching the MILLENNIUM EXPERIMENT at Brisbane is answering all questions in this regard and, of course, is also raising questions which you may apply yourself in your way into our project.

**Bernd Siebler "What are we going to do with the new time travel technology?"**

If it would be as easy as a little magic to manifest something concrete out of nothing then we would not have to talk about our invention today, which doesn't exist in our century yet. No, it is **not simple**, but it would be **simply ignorant** for us not to use the opportunity presented to us to write a definite part of history for the evolutionarily advance of mankind as a whole.

Let us assume as indicated that our experiment is a success deriving from a quantum physical and scientific point of view by a factor of 90 %+X then we would have at our disposal a procedure for implementing travels through time back to the past and into the future after the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2012. The following would happen with a high degree of probability:

**NOTHING!**

Why? Because we have promised the bearer (a HE who can also be of course a SHE) of the time travel procedure, (for simplicity's sake let's say "time machine") to be able to return to his or her own time and this promise will be kept.

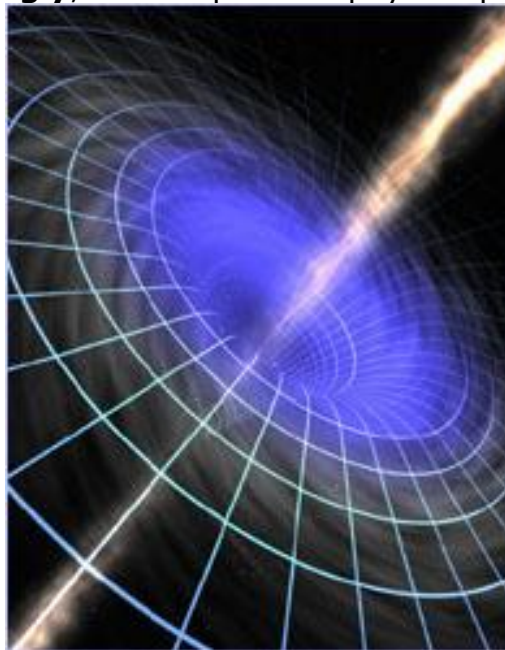
At the same time: without this promise probably nobody from the future would execute our order from year 2012; it's as simple as that.

To further soothe worried souls: the bearer will in his supposed year of launching in 2500 transfer the time machine to 2012 – most probably undertake (for example) a short leap to 2501 to assure himself PRIOR to his commencement of travel that his mission – in other words – acceptance of our order is **safe** and **risk-free**. If he was no longer able to proceed compliantly with the “double-check ambience” in 2501, a cancellation of the experiment would be the quite natural consequence!

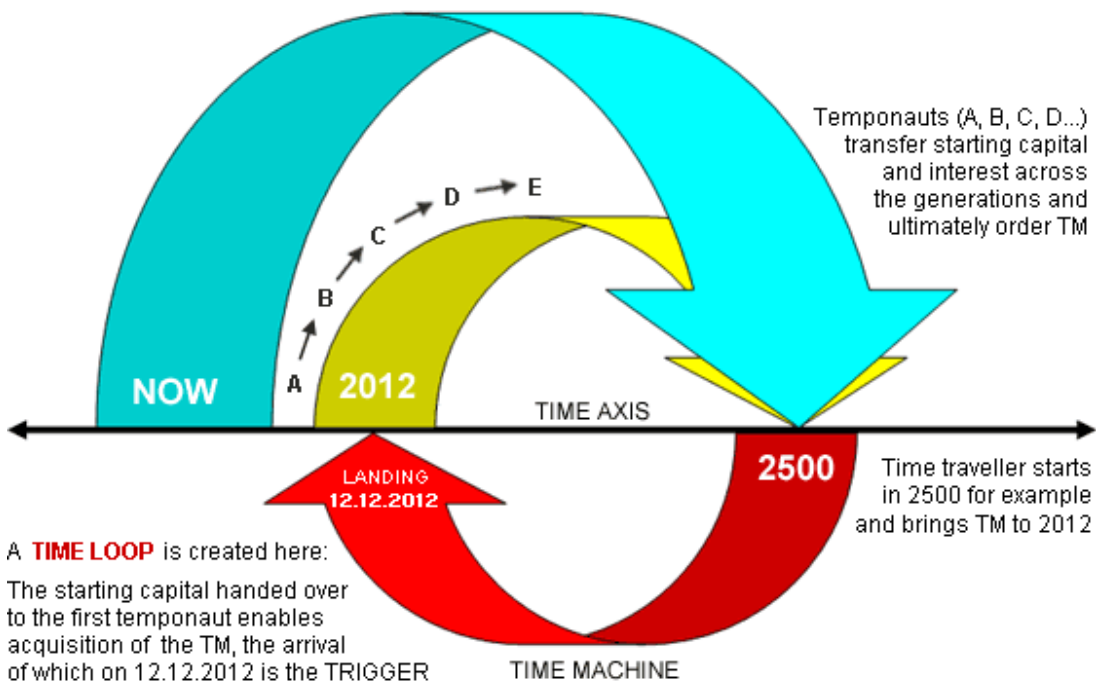
The question: “What will WE do with the new time-travel technology?” must therefore be **reformulated**, since WE obviously have little or no influence at all on what could be done with this invention appearing from the future in 2012.

If we would have a **hidden** agenda, then the bearers of the ordered technology by us would be able to check that easily via a leap into their future and prevent it by not appearing, as we have just explained.

If we behave **accordingly**, from a quantum physical point of view we will



create precisely the “break through” from the future to the past, namely **the 12.12.2012**, without which the development of time-travel technology in the future would not be possible ... and with that we as “equal partners” are suddenly and unexpectedly back in the game and become a practically indispensable component of the FUTURE.



A **TIME LOOP** is created here:  
 The starting capital handed over to the first temponaut enables acquisition of the TM, the arrival of which on 12.12.2012 is the TRIGGER for the cumulative starting capital that is forwarded by the temponauts to the year of TM procurement

Temponauts (A, B, C, D...) transfer starting capital and interest across the generations and ultimately order TM

Time traveller starts in 2500 for example and brings TM to 2012

**TM** = Procedure for enabling physical time travel  
**Time traveller** = Transferor of the procedure  
**Temponaut** = Participant in the "Millennium Experiment"  
**Starting capital** = € 90,000 > 1/3 forwarding reward for temponaut "A", 2/3 + interest for temponaut "B" etc. \*\*

\*\* in the event of assumed acquisition of TM in the year 2500 the purchaser/hirer himself has - estimated conservatively - more than 5 BILLION in capital at his disposal (see also table)

So we now have the 'Time Machine' standing at our ordered location and at our specific time on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> month of the year 2012 and we are now staring into the eye of some individual from year 2500, to choose a sensible year in the distant future.

Correct! We have purchased **the rights of use** for the 'vehicle' for a twenty four hour period in our calculation of time. We were required to pay a price of the equivalent of roughly 5 billion Euros. For the initial capital outlay of 60,000 Euros back in year 2012 including moderate interest charges and taking into account the inflation rate and a one-third payment to the 'torchbearers' over a cycle of thirty years of duty had increased exactly to 5 billion, 369 trillion, 114 million, 232 thousand, 695 Euros by 2500 or whatever people are going to call the currency by then.

Now of course, we could hand the time machine over to some kind of government or another institution, which would take its time to dismantle it to be able to built a more or less operational replica .....and our bearers from 2500 who were guaranteed to start their journey back home within twenty-four hours of delivery would accede their journey on the '*day hell freezes over*' or would end up in quarantine or some other worse place.

As already explained they had identified this **breach of contract** during the prearrangements for their journey after a brief trial leap into the near future, for they might simply not have come back at the right time or maybe they might never even have returned at all.

Now you might object: maybe time travel is only possible in one direction, namely into the past, so that 'such stipulations' are impossible by travellers.

I think we can happily dismiss that objection, because if a time leap into the future would be impossible the return of the bearers of the time machine from 2012 going back and forth to their chosen presents of 2500 would not be permitted ... And the journey into the past from their point of view would have been therefore nothing but a dead end street. If our descendents, however, should be UNABLE to travel into their own future this would'nt change anything in their ability to provide us a time travel procedure NOW.

Feel free to succumb to impatience and to pose the question: "In actual fact what are we going to do, if we get our hands on a time machine on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> month of the year 2012 and are not about to pass it on to some defence or intelligence or such other person for the reasons outlined?"

I repeat: **NOTHING!**

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The fact is that the 'breakthrough' from the future took place at all. This **IS** the result of our experiment and the benefits for OUR future are going to be tremendous:

1. We have proven that time travels are possible, in itself a banality and superficially without obvious impact on our contemporary existence, but
2. In every aspect we should be able to look forward to a peaceful and thoroughly **liveable** future, for; if we have had a view at "our time machine" from the future then there is a progressive future with no chaos, no annihilation, and rather there is an intelligent species from which we can always learn something NOW.

Which means: "The future **protects our** present under the totally new aspects of the 'millennium experiment'."

If we would destroy ourselves tomorrow or the day after tomorrow, there would be most likely not any **liveable** future and nobody would be in a position to invent something as highly developed as a time travel procedure.

However with an existing time machine the contemporaries wouldn't have an elementary interest in the past being destroyed itself, because they would not exist themselves.

- since they **do** have the "power" over the future, they will do everything to ensure their own through the positive manipulation of the past ... and likewise for this reason make a peaceful present and future possible for us.

Ladies and Gentlemen, here and now in the **present**,  
You have foreseen it correctly:

the ladies and gentlemen of the **future**  
need **us**,  
and we need **them**,  
to ensure our own future in peace and liberty.

Allow me to extend the thread of my hypothetical argument a little further: Do we know that our decedents have influenced our present effectively to safe their own future long ago?



**An example:** The 'gradual downfall' of the Soviet Union as a real representation of a 'world- controlling- wanting to be Communism' was and is 'surreal', whereas 'pressing the nuclear button' would have been the 'real prospect'. Preventing an essentially inevitable military 'Armageddon', as well as to deactivate an ideological totalitarian uncompromising system to the surprise of everybody, in my opinion, would have been due to the interference from the future in using our "time machine" here.

According to a high degree of probability the time machine is potentially the 'true global police force', which we have to thank for our current existence, although it would have been more possible that we would have blown up our planet with ourselves long ago. But let's just leave this thesis stand on its own as an entirely personal interpretation of mine of peculiar historical processes, without wishing to derive any dogma from it.

Obviously we should not allow ourselves to be 'blue eyed' and let the ordered time machine for the 12<sup>th</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> month of the year 2012 stand in a corner for the entire twenty-four hour-trial period, even though it has demonstrated its effectiveness by its own appearance in the first place.



A brief trial journey to Ancient Egypt or Mayan Mexico to **observe** how their gigantic pyramids were really constructed would then be definitely granted, if we don't change anything through our micro-presence and only verify the operation in that time frame. In this respect there is no danger for our contractors of the future, because they are able to audit themselves the effects of such a 'trial time travel' in their own time.

This brings us close to the end of 'our journey'.

For those who regard my 'practical' explanations and those of my colleague Walther Gith of the 'faculty of theoretical-quantum physics' as overly visionary, I would like to present a short retrospect: "Who would have dreamed of imagining that only 500 years later after the first



burning of more than over 100,000 witches took place in Europe in 1506 more than a billion people would be flying through the air within one year only?

Why should time travel not exist after "500 years of the



Jumbo-Jet"?

Why should it not be possible to 'manipulate' not only the 'earth, the water and the air,' but the time as well?

I am telling you: whoever thinks that time proceeds linearly without any deviation in one direction is mistaken. Time does not exist as we might perhaps like it to be. Time is nothing but a 'vinyl record' with an infinite number of grooves which have simultaneously 'recorded' an **infinite past** and an **infinite future** whereby our present amounts to a tiny cross-section of those infinities which we call the 'Now.'

And whomsoever doesn't please this deterministically reflection of time may possibly make friends with the assumption that time itself does not exist at all, however, will only be understandable as a space-time continuum, or -what's actually and seriously discussed in physicist circles- that every essential decision of ourselves is leading to some sort of a parallel universe with different conditions.

Perhaps we will learn more about if our experiment succeeds and we will be allowed to recall the knowledge of our descendants.

As a matter of course and in terms of our **Time**-experiment you may now burn me at the stake for having altered Galileo's "and yet it moves" to **"and we control it yet"!**
